



Dear B Block parent

It's that time of year when we advertise for the opportunity to take part in either the Japanese or New York exchange programmes. Due to the large volume of interest in both trips over recent years, the following rules will apply to register interest:

- A child can apply to take part in one or the other, but not both exchange programmes.
- In the event of over subscription, names shall be drawn out of a hat at random. Selection is not on a first come, first served basis.
- These trips are best suited to children that live locally or have the facility to host in or around Oxford as part of the exchange programme. There are limited spaces for boarders and hosting in the boarding Houses is not viable.
- Parents of hosting children will need to submit to a full DBS clearance by the school.

Dates for the exchanges are as follows:

Japan Exchange – In Oxford from 22 April to 2 May 2017

In Tokyo from 18 to 27 October 2017

New York Exchange – In New York from 23 to 31 October 2017

In Oxford from 15 to 19 June 2018

It is also worth considering whether your child is actually suitable and prepared to spend a large amount of time away from home in a strange environment and please have this discussion with your child in advance.
